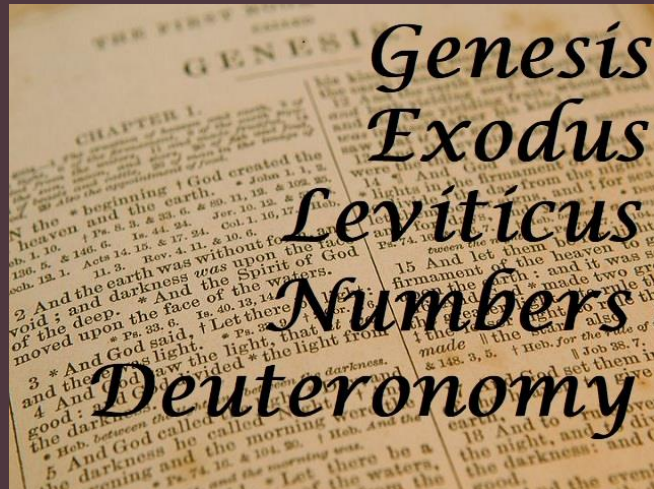

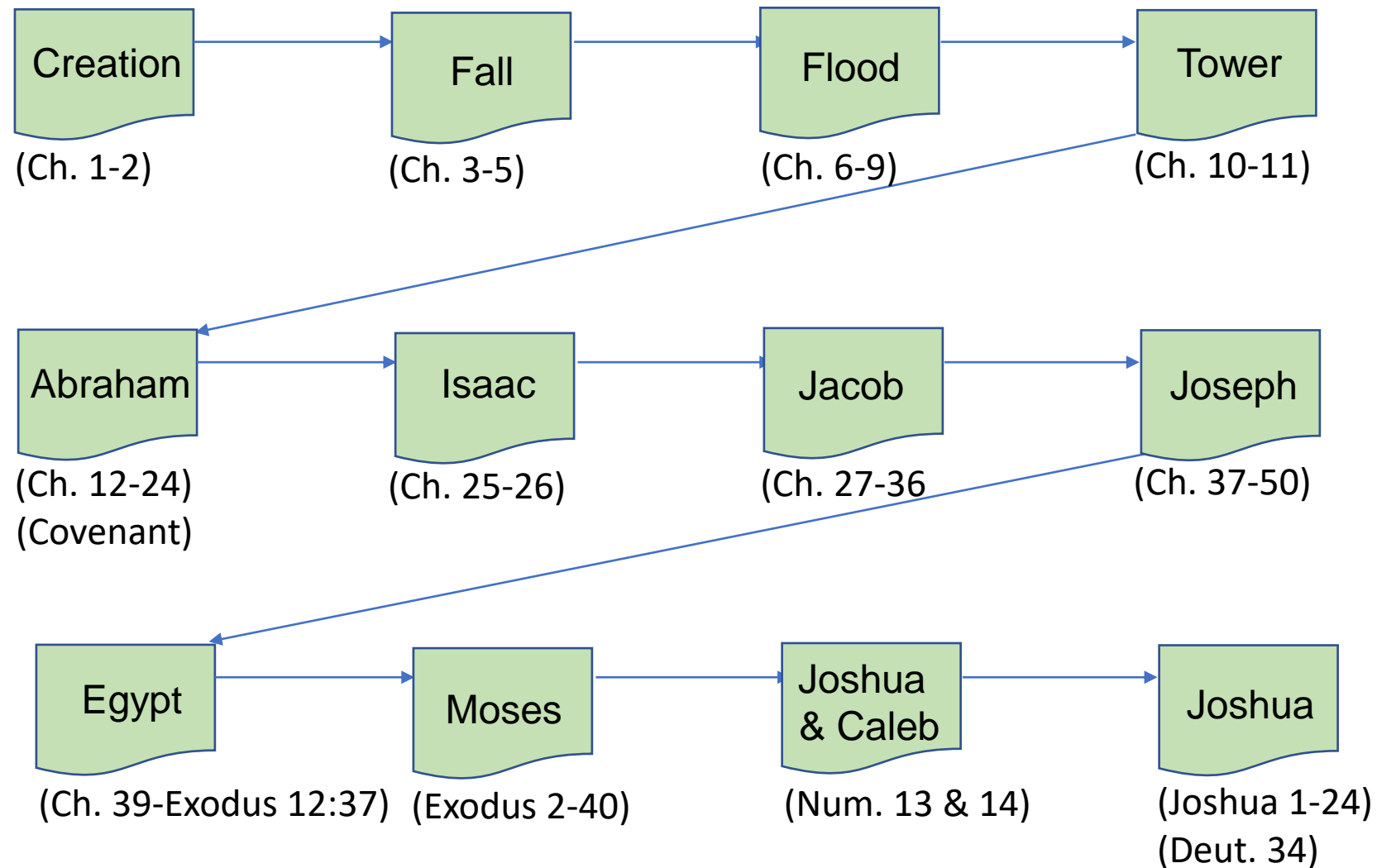
Key Verses

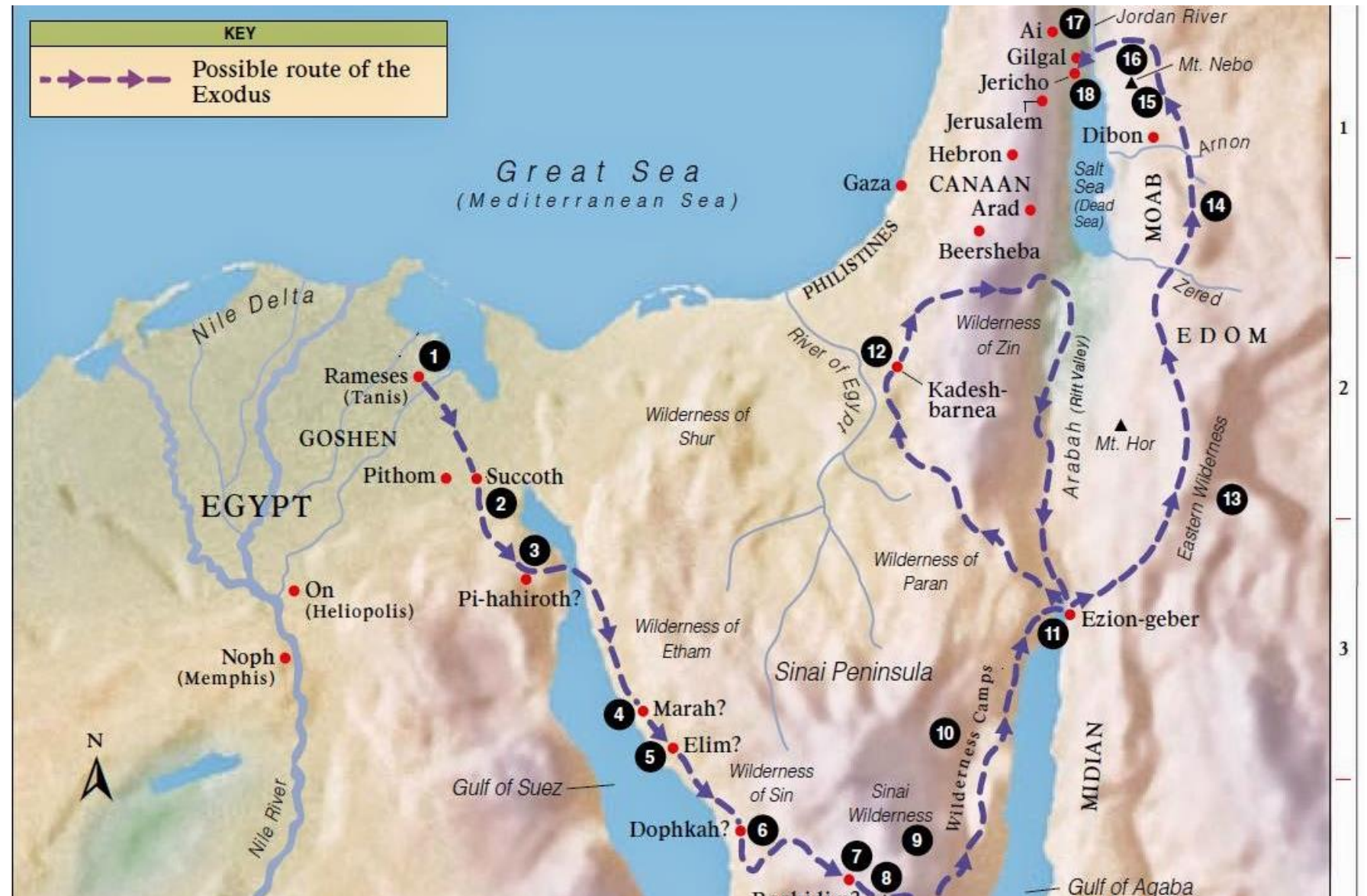
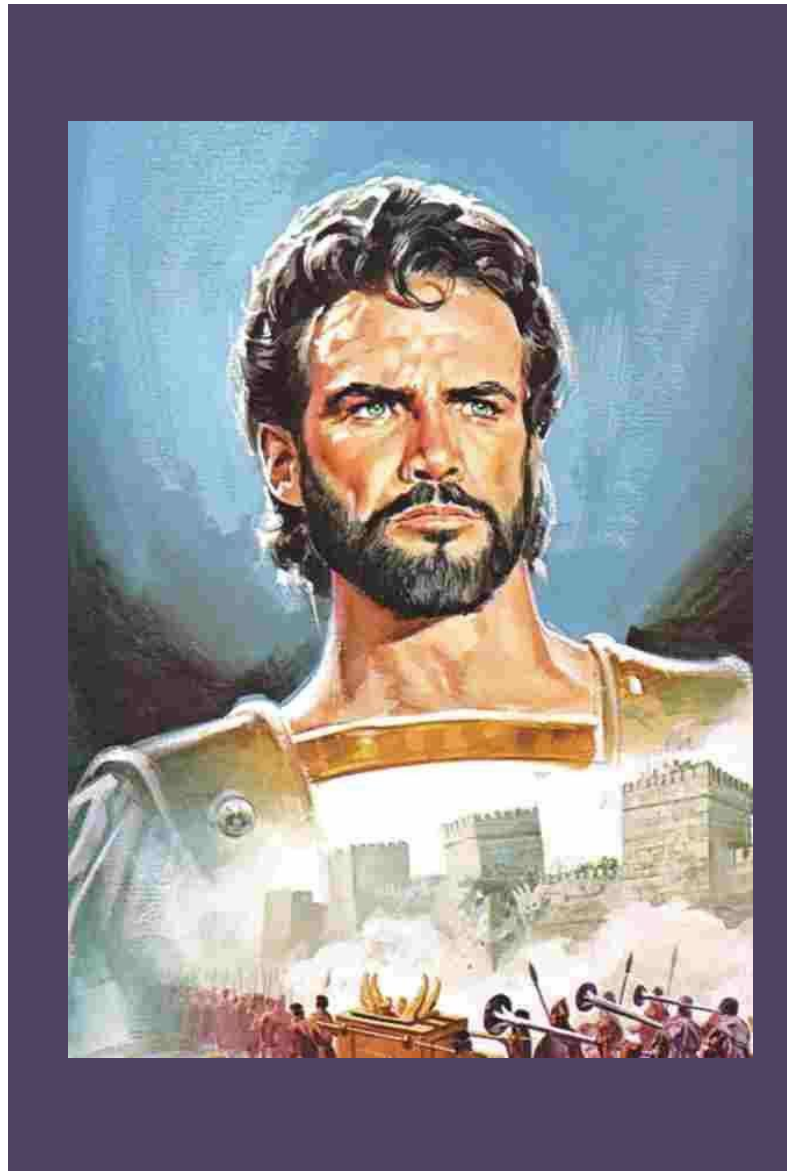
